Aboriginal Student Bursary Application 2014

This summer, Queen's Aboriginal Access to Engineering is sponsoring an Aboriginal Student Bursary for local First Nations, Métis and Inuit youth to attend Science Quest camps.

First Nations, Métis and Inuit campers may apply for a bursary that covers the total cost of regular camp fees, to a maximum of \$210 per child over the period of June 30 – August 29, 2014.

To be eligible, parents or guardians are asked to provide evidence of Aboriginal ancestry (status card, Métis identity card, letter of support from community, etc.) when submitting this form.

Please note the following:

- **You must register for camp before requesting a bursary.** When filling out the registration, please state you are planning on applying for this bursary.
- **No payment (including registration deposit) is due** until you have been contacted with a decision regarding your bursary (indicate paying by cheque/bursary on deposit page).
